WORDS ON WORSHIP

Today we celebrate Ascension Sunday, when, after rising from the dead and being present with the apostles and others for forty days, Jesus gives his last instructions before being taken up into heaven. Meeting together at the Mount of Olives, Jesus tells the apostles to teach in Judea, Samaria and to the ends of the earth (Act 1:8) and promises they will receive special power to carry out this "Great Commission" (see also Matthew 28:18-20; Mark 16:15-16; Luke 24:47; John 20:21). This turning point in the Bible further reveals the Trinity through emphasizing the power of God the Spirit.
